

**Comment on: "Project Management Integration on Development Environments"**

Project management is frequently limited to the administration of constrained resources. Because of this initial misunderstanding, project managers tend to reduce their jobs to the computation of productivity measures that would help them better estimate durations and costs.

The approach of this presentation is completely different. It leverages project management to the mission of identifying and creating tools and methodologies specifically focused on improving the execution of a project from the inside, as opposed to a conventional supervision of scheduled tasks. The pertinent distinction between industry and research developments shows a genuine intention to address the problem with rigor and incisiveness.
